 - 1) Employee Recognition: Keara Drew, Sheriff's Office, 10 years
 - 2) Roz Burke, Stephanie Bryant and A.G. Howell for Child Abuse Prevention Month Proclamation.
 - 3) Motion to execute the FY 2021-22 Wayne County Intermediate Punishment Program grant application in the amount of \$90,000 and the program authorization form. This funding, through the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency, will help cover the costs of wages for the primary IP Probation Officer, drug and alcohol treatment and restrictive conditions for individuals eligible for the Intermediate Punishment Program.
 - 4) Upon recommendation of County Engineer Steve Knash, motion to appoint Kiley Associates, LLC as civil engineer on the Hankins Dam/Park project and to accept their professional service proposal in the amount of \$15,000.
